

Kairos of Texas – Hutchins Prayer Chain Guidelines

Overview: On Friday of the Weekend, during the first discussion of agape (Christ-like love), a prayer chain is brought out and is draped around the room and around/over all the Brothers in White. This is meant to be an overwhelming display of just how many people on the outside are praying for the Brothers during the Weekend. The chain links are alternating colors and oftentimes include links from Brothers/Sisters at other Institutions. Each link also has the first name and city of a person praying for the Weekend.

- Prayer chains must be on colored paper. If possible, print each sheet in a different color – the more colors the better. White paper is reserved for prison residents to create prayer chain links. Green is usually reserved for children/youth, but this is not a hard requirement.
- Prayer chains should be printed on thicker paper like bond paper or construction papers. Card stock is ok but is a little harder to work with.
- First names only and city on the prayer chain links.
- Prayer chain will be assembled at the church the Thursday morning of the Kairos weekend. Be sure that the Prayer Chain Links get to the meeting site a week before the Thursday start to insure that your links make it to the “chain”.
- These are free to anyone who is willing to pray for the weekend. Each signature on each link must be prayed over, asking God that He will use your links to make each Man in White that they are NOT ALONE.
