Kairos of Texas – Hutchins Meal Ticket Instructions

Overview: At each meal during the weekend, a meal ticket is placed by each person's plate. This ticket shows the Brother's first name and city of the person on the outside who paid for his meal. It also reminds the inmate that someone they've never met loves them enough to provide this meal. This is another tangible example of agape (Christ-like love).

- Meal tickets may be sold for as little as \$5.00. Each meal for the weekend costs about \$5 to prepare. However,
 - o If the contributor doesn't have \$5.00 to pay for a meal ticket, get the meal ticket signed and graciously accept the ticket without a contribution.
 - o If the contributor wants to give more either
 - Accept whatever they are willing to contribute and/or
 - Let them sign more than one ticket

NOTE: Remember, while monetary contributions are needed to sustain this program, sharing God's love by reassuring the Men in White that someone cared enough to sponsor their meal on that day.

- Meal tickets should be printed on white card stock in color.
- First name and city of the contributor only on the meal tickets
- Let people know this is a way that they can donate a little money that will make a
 <u>HUGE IMPACT</u> on someone's life.
- Tell the contributor that they should pray every day for the success of the of Kairos weekend that God's miracle will touch the hearts and minds of each and every incarcerated man.
